LEGENDARY ROCKER ALICE COOPER IS RETURNING TO THE MYSTIC SHOWROOM MAY 5

PRIOR LAKE, Minn. – Jan. 23, 2023 – Legendary rocker Alice Cooper is returning to the Mystic Showroom at 8 p.m. Friday, May 5.

Alice Cooper pioneered a grandly theatrical brand of hard rock that was designed to shock. Drawing equally from horror movies, vaudeville and garage rock, the group created a stage show that featured electric chairs, guillotines, fake blood and boa constrictors. He continues to tour regularly, performing shows worldwide with the dark and horror-themed theatrics that he's best known for.

The singer brings his own brand of rock psychodrama to fans both old and new, enjoying it as much as the audience does. Known as the architect of shock rock, Cooper has rattled the cages and undermined the authority of generations of guardians of the status quo, continuing to surprise fans and exude danger at every turn.

With his influence on rock and roll and popular culture long since acknowledged, there is little that Alice Cooper hasn't achieved in his remarkable career, including Platinum albums, sold-out tours and any number of honors and career achievement awards. ABOUT ALICE COOPER

The Alice Cooper band formed while they were all in high school in Phoenix and were discovered in 1969 by Frank Zappa. Their collaboration with young record producer Bob Ezrin led to the breakthrough albums "Love It to Death," "Killer," "School's Out," "Billion Dollar Babies" and "Muscle of Love." The group was inducted into the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame in 2011.

Cooper's solo career skyrocketed in the late 1970s with a succession of hit singles, including "You & Me" and classic albums including "Lace And Whiskey" and "From The Inside."

In the '80s he explored different sounds, highlighted by the new wavish album "Flush The Fashion," the heavy metal "Constrictor" and "Raise Your Fist And Yell." 1989's melodic hard rock album "Trash," featuring the massive hit single "Poison" became his biggest-selling album and single worldwide.

In addition to hit songs like "No More Mr. Nice Guy," "I'm Eighteen" and "School's Out," Cooper has made numerous appearances in movies and television. His most memorable movie appearance was as himself in "Wayne's World" and as Freddy Krueger's wicked stepfather in "Freddy's Dead: The Final Nightmare."

Along with a groundbreaking network TV special "Alice Cooper: The Nightmare," the singer has also appeared on "The Muppet Show" and "That '70s Show." He recently performed as King Herod in NBC's live production of "Jesus Christ Superstar."

Released in February 2021, his latest album, "Detroit Stories," entered Billboard's album sales chart at No. 1 and charted high upon release in the UK, Germany, Australia, Sweden and other countries.

Twenty-plus years into the new millennium, Cooper continues to be very productive and busy writing, recording and releasing albums. His nightly radio show, "Nights With Alice Cooper," continues to air in nearly 100 cities in the US, Canada, Australia and the UK.
