ROCK ICON ROB ZOMBIE TO PERFORM WITH FILTER IN THE MYSTIC AMPHITHEATER JULY 8

PRIOR LAKE, Minn. – May 9, 2023 – Rock icon Rob Zombie will take the Mystic Amphitheater stage with Filter at 8 p.m. Saturday, July 8.

As a rock icon and filmmaker with a unique vision, Rob Zombie has continuously challenged audiences as he stretches the boundaries of both music and film. He has sold more than fifteen million albums worldwide and is the only artist to experience unprecedented success in both music and film.

Rob Zombie has achieved great success in the music industry first as a member of the multi-Platinum band White Zombie and later as a solo artist with even greater results collecting numerous multi-Platinum and Gold albums along the way including "Hellbilly Deluxe," "The Sinister Urge" and "Educated Horses."

His latest album, "The Lunar Injection Kool Aid Eclipse Conspiracy," was released in 2021. It is a classic Zombie album through and through with high-energy rages like "The Eternal Struggles of the Howling Man" and heavy-groove thumpers like "Shadow of the Cemetery Man." "The Lunar Injection Kool Aid Eclipse Conspiracy," debuted at No. 9 on Billboard's Top 200 chart, making it his seventh consecutive solo album to debut in the top 10.

In 2023, Rob Zombie is celebrating the 25th anniversary of his debut solo album, "Hellbilly Deluxe," as well as the 20th anniversary of his debut cult-favorite film, "House of 1,000 Corpses."

ABOUT FILTER

Diversity has been a hallmark of Richard Patrick's career, and it's administered with crushing efficiency on his latest eclectic set of new material from his band Filter.

Filter was originally formed in Cleveland, Ohio, in 1993 when Patrick desired to start his own band after leaving Nine Inch Nails as their touring guitarist. Their debut album, "Short Bus," was released in 1995 and ended up going Platinum, largely due to the success of the single "Hey Man Nice Shot." The follow-up, 1999's "Title of Record," also went Platinum, driven by the success of the song "Take a Picture."

Patrick, the lone constant member of the veteran industrial rock act, reunited with original Filter programmer and producer Brian Liesegang to write several songs on "For The Beaten," the band's first new album in five years.
