Borden (drums), Ryan Ware (bass/vocals), Chris Hicks (guitar/vocals), Rick Willis (guitar/vocals) and Marcus James Henderson (keyboards/saxophone/flute/vocals).

The band's mighty music catalog, consisting of more than 20 studio albums and a score of live releases, has racked up multi-Platinum album sales many times over. They are best known for hit songs like "Heard It in a Love Song," "Can't You See," "Fire on the Mountain," "Long Hard Ride" and "Ramblin'."
