2024 has been a monumental year for Glaser, starting with her standout performance at the Emmy-nominated Tom Brady Roast, which earned her viral attention and reinstated her title as “the best roaster on the planet.” Shortly afterwards, Glaser premiered her highly anticipated second HBO comedy special, “Someday You’ll Die,” on May 11, for which she received her first Emmy Award nomination after nearly two decades in the industry.

Glaser has captivated audiences with her trademark honest and unapologetic humor and now more fans can enjoy more nights filled with laughter.

Glaser will kick off 2025 by hosting the 82nd annual Golden Globe Awards on Jan. 5 before resuming her tour on Jan. 31 at Mystic Lake.

For nearly two decades at sold-out tours and as the host of three hit podcasts, Emmy-nominated comedian Nikki Glaser has honed her shockingly honest, no-holds-barred style. She has solidified herself as one of the funniest voices in comedy today.

Following the success of her Critics Choice Award-nominated HBO standup special, “Good Clean Filth,” Glaser recently premiered her highly anticipated second HBO special, “Someday You’ll Die.” The show earned Glaser her first Emmy nomination for Outstanding Variety Special (Pre-Recorded). The special set the record for both the best premiere night for an HBO comedy special in more than two years and for the No. 1 largest streaming audience for a comedy special in Max history.

Glaser was the standout on Netflix’s Emmy-nominated “The Greatest Roast of All Time: Tom Brady,” which earned her viral attention. She is set to host the Golden Globe Awards on Jan. 5 and is currently the host and executive producer of the CW dating series “Lovers and Liars.”

Glaser has had multiple stand-up specials and late-night television appearances in which she jokes about her most humiliating moments as a woman in the modern world. Her past and current struggles with anorexia, depression and anxiety, are fair game in both her stand-up and in-depth interviews with “The Howard Stern Show,” “WTF with Marc Maron,” “Conan O’Brien Needs a Friend” and “The Joe Rogan Experience.” She has become a complete open book on mic, being the empowering voice for women that she yearned for as a confused adolescent.

Glaser launched “The Nikki Glaser Podcast” in 2021. Her Netflix comedy special, “Bangin’,” was the most-watched special on Netflix when it premiered in 2019. She was a standout at the “Comedy Central Roasts” of Alec Baldwin, Bruce Willis and Rob Lowe, which led to her guest hosting “Jimmy Kimmel Live!” She has had memorable film and television roles in “Trainwreck,” NBC’s “AP Bio” and “Inside Amy Schumer.” She also came in third place on the ninth season of the hit FOX series “The Masked Singer.” For more information, visit nikkiqlaser.com.
