AN EVENING WITH LARRY THE CABLE GUY IS COMING TO MYSTIC LAKE APRIL 11

Tickets on sale Jan. 16

PRIOR LAKE, Minn. – Jan. 12, 2026 – Prepare to laugh when An Evening with Larry the Cable Guy comes to the Mystic Showroom at 8 p.m. Saturday, April 11, 2026.

Larry the Cable Guy is a multi-Platinum recording artist, Grammy nominee, Billboard award winner and one of the top comedians in the country. He rose to stardom with the “Blue Collar Comedy Tour,” alongside Jeff Foxworthy and Bill Engvall. The tour grossed over \$15 million and led to several hit specials, including “Blue Collar Comedy Tour: The Movie,” which became Comedy Central’s highest-rated movie at the time and sold more than four million DVDs. Its sequel, “Blue Collar Comedy Tour Rides Again,” sold over three million copies and “Blue Collar Comedy Tour: One for the Road” premiered in 2006 to strong ratings and a Grammy nomination for its soundtrack.

Larry’s debut comedy album, “Lord, I Apologize,” achieved Gold status and spent 15 weeks at No. 1 on the Billboard Comedy Charts. His follow-up, “Git-R-Done,” sold over one million copies and was certified Platinum. “The Right to Bare Arms” debuted at No. 1 across multiple charts, including comedy, country and the Billboard Top 200. It made history as the first comedy album to top the Country Chart. It also earned a Grammy nomination and Gold certification. “Morning Constitutions” and “A Very Larry Christmas” were also chart-topping releases, with the latter achieving Platinum status.

Larry is the voice of the beloved Mater in Disney/Pixar’s “Cars” franchise. “Cars” and “Cars 2” both opened at No. 1 at the box office and have grossed over one billion worldwide. He returned as Mater in “Cars 3” and the Disney+ series “Cars on the Road.” Larry also starred in “Jingle All The Way 2.” Other recent film credits include “A Madea Christmas,” “Tooth Fairy 2,” “Witless Protection,” “Delta Farce” and his first feature, “Larry the Cable Guy: Health Inspector,” which sold over one million copies on DVD in its first week of release.

ABOUT LARRY THE CABLE GUY

Larry was Billboard's 2005 Comedy Artist of the Year and won the 2006 Comedy Album of the Year and Top Comedy Tour awards. He executive produced and starred in "The Comedy Central Roast of Larry the Cable Guy," which attracted 4.1 million viewers and remains one of the highest-rated roasts in the network's history.

In early 2012, "Them Idiots Whirled Tour" aired on Country Music Television and debuted at No. 1 on the Billboard Comedy Charts. His 2009 special, "Tailgate Party," aired on Comedy Central and became a top-selling DVD and CD, both debuting at No. 1 on the Billboard Comedy Charts.

Larry hosted "Only in America with Larry the Cable Guy" on History for three seasons. The show was a ratings success, taking viewers behind the scenes of unique American lifestyles, jobs and cultural experiences. He also appeared on the hit FOX show "The Masked Singer," where he showed off his vocal talents as the character "Baby." In addition, he has the comedy channel "Jeff and Larry's Comedy Roundup" on SiriusXM, which highlights the best in great American comedy.

Larry's Git-R-Done Foundation, founded in 2009 with his wife, Cara, focuses on children's and veterans' causes. Beneficiaries include the Arnold Palmer Hospital, Operation Homefront, and Madonna Rehabilitation Hospital.

He released his brand-new comedy special, "Larry the Cable Guy: It's a Gift," on Amazon Prime in September. His special, "Remain Seated," is currently streaming on Netflix and his bestselling book, "Git-R-Done," debuted at No. 26 on the New York Times bestseller list.
